Every Wednesday at 6.30 p.m. from 13 May to 21 October, at the Pavillon de la France, French researchers have been shedding light on the problem "Feeding the Planet, energy for life" for fifteen minutes.

These short, dynamic TAG conferences give an understanding of the major innovation and research challenges in agriculture and food from a sustainable development perspective. They cover five themes: Food, Agriculture, Climate change, Environment and Health.

The speakers come from major French research and training institutions in the field: universities, public research institutions, colleges and foundations. The themes addressed give a snapshot of France's contribution to global food issues through managing and protecting natural resources, the new agriculture models, food security, etc.
